 BE UNITED***

Week 3 Review

***The Church must: MOVE TOWARDS TRUTH
 MOVE AWAY FROM SIN
 MOVE TOWARDS PURPOSE***

Week 4 Review

In order for Rock Pike to be **“A Biblical Church”** we must:

***The Church must: BE AVAILABLE
 BE EQUIPPED
 BE FAITHFUL***

1. CONFIDENT IN THE RESURRECTION

✝ Acts 2:24 ~ Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.

2. CONFIDENT OF AN ETERNAL HELL

✝ Acts 2:27 ~ Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

3. CONFIDENT OF AN ETERNAL HEAVEN

✝ Acts 2:32 ~ This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

✝ Acts 2:33 ~ Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

✝ Acts 2:34 ~ For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

4. CONFIDENT THAT JESUS IS LORD

✝ Acts 2:36 ~ Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

BE LOYAL – (to the LORD we serve)

BE FEARLESS – (in our stand for HIM)

BE BOLD – (in proclaiming HIS message)
